Tickets for Expo 2010

Expo Peak day includes May 1-3, Oct 1-7 & 25-31, total 17 days.

Expo opening time:

09:00 Expo site opens for entry

09:30 Expo pavilions open for visit

22:30 Expo pavilions close for visit

24:00 Expo site closes

Purchase channels:

2) Call 24-hour expo ticket hotline with free delivery, 12580 (China Mobile), 118114/114 (China Telecom), 11185 (China Post)

4) During 6-month Expo, self-purchase machines will be set up and visitors can buy tickets from Expo gate ticket booths

Note: Evening tickets can be only purchased at Expo site with entry after 5pm on the same day, not including 17 Expo peak days, no advance purchase.

Please Note the following restrictions:

1. Peak Day Single Day Admission

- for all visitors
- on the designated day or any Standard Day
- one ticket per person, valid for one entry on the day of admission

2. Standard Day Single Day Admission

- for all visitors
- one any Standard Day other than Peak Day
- one ticket per person, valid for one entry on the day of admission

3. Peak Day Special Admission

- for the disabled
- people born in or before 1950
- students with valid IDs
- children above 1.2m
- children military personnel on active duty
- one ticket per person, valid for one entry on the day of admission

4. Standard Day Special Admission

- people born in or before 1950
- students with valid IDs
- children above 1.2m
- for Chinese military personnel on active duty
- valid IDs are required upon ticket purchase and entry
- on any Standard Day other than Peak Day
- one ticket per person, valid for one entry on the day of admission

5. 3 Day Admission

- for all visitors
- valid for any three days except Peak Days
- one ticket per person, valid for one entry per day

6. 7 Day Admission

- for all visitors
- valid for any seven days except Peak Days
- one ticket per person, valid for one entry per day

7. Evening Admission

- After 5pm except Peak Days
- one ticket per person, valid for one entry on the day of admission

8. Group Admission tickets available for authorized travel agents only.

- for groups of 15+
- valid for one entry on the day of admission
- should be purchased in advance and reservation is required before entry

9. Student Group Admission - For authorized travel agents and education institutes only.

- groups of 30+
- valid for one entry on the day of admission
- for standard day only
- should be purchased in advance and reservation is required before entry

Please be noted that:

Expo Peak-day ticket: advance purchase before 30 April, 2010

- 1) Expo Peak day includes May 1-3, Oct 1-7 & 25-31, total 17 days.
- 2) Expo peak day tickets can only be purchased before 30 April, 2010 without on-the-spot purchase.

Expo 3-day & 7-day tickets (for Expo non-peak day):

These two types of multi-entry tickets can be only used once per day.

Note: Evening tickets can be only purchased at Expo site with entry after 5pm on the same day, not including 17 Expo peak days, no advance purchase.
