The microorganisms refer to viruses, bacteria, fungi, actinobacteria, rickettsias, spirochaetes, chlamydiae, mycoplasmas and other medical bacterial (viral) species or specimens, as well as parasite, and environmental microbial agents.

The human tissues refer to human cells, cell lines, embryos, organs, tissues, marrows, excreta, ordures, etc.

The biological products refer to bio-active agents that are used in the fields of human medicine and life sciences, including vaccines, antitoxins, diagnostic reagents, cytokines, enzymes and their preparations, toxins, antigens, idiotoxins, antibodies, antigen-antibody complex, nucleic acids, immunomodulators, microbial ecological agents, etc.

The blood refers to blood cells, blood plasma and other blood constituents.

The blood products refer to all types of plasma protein products.
